Over the course of the last month, I've attended a number of key meetings including Georgia Public Policy Foundation – Transportation, CID Alliance, ARC Transportation Coordinating Committee.

Funding opportunities continue to be a priority as we monitor the Federal TEA-21 reauthorization and made application for ARC LCI study funds.

Issues:

- GDOT median project – plans completed within days
- ARC LCI grant – application filed, award anticipated by March 2004
- CID Alliance – Jan 15 meeting to formulate legislative agenda
- Newsletter in the mail, surveys coming in – 6 pages at lower cost
- ARC TIP – priorities by Jan 23, new applications by Feb 6 – County/City
- Overlay District – Mall of GA, Civic Center approved – Jan/Fed Hwy 78
- Award prime consultant contract at Jan. 21 BOD meeting
